2. Teaching Method

In principle, classes in Medical Science Course are conducted in English. However, students can also take classes in Japanese offered for Medical Science Course in Fukushima Medical University. Regarding the classes offered by Fukushima Medical University, students take distance classes by video conferencing system.

3. Requirements for Course Completion

Students are required to attend school for 2 years or longer, obtain 34 credits or more, receive necessary instructions for research and pass screening of master's thesis and final examination. Screening of master's thesis can be substituted with their academic achievement such as publication of journal with peer review, conference presentation and those equivalent which are regarded as superior to those of master thesis when the Faculty Meeting approves so.

Besides, students whose accomplishment get recognized at the Faculty Meeting are allowed to finish the course when they attend school for more than 1 year.

4. Necessary Credits

- ① Basic Subjects: 12 credits or more
 - 8 credits from Required Subjects, 4 credits or more from Elective Subjects
- ② Specialized Subjects: 12 credits or more
 - 4 credits from Required Subjects, 4 credits from Required Elective Subjects, 4 credits or more from Elective subjects
- ③ Specialized Training: 4 credits or more
- 4 Research Project: 6 credits
- ⑤ Optional Subject
 - Students who have not taken subjects related to medicine (Students graduated from department of economics, psychology, education, sciences and engineering etc or students who completed master courses of those majors) are required to take Basic medicine (2 credits) to gain an understanding of basic knowledge for medical sciences at the first semester of the first year.
- ⑥ More than 10 credits out of 34 credits or more shall be of the subjects Fukushima Medical University offers.

Training program on Certified nurse specialist of Radiological nursing

Nagasaki University Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences offers training program on certified nurse specialist of radiological nursing. Applicants must have a license of nurse. The necessary credits shall be provided for separately.

5. Standards for the Establishment of Graduate Schools (Article 14) (Application of the Special Case)

Nagasaki University Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences may, if it is deemed to be especially necessary from an educational standpoint, conduct classes or provide research instructions at night or at other appropriate times. Students who wish such arrangement may take classes and receive research instructions at night, or at other appropriate times in addition to day time upon discussions with their supervisors. In principle, arrangement shall be made between the period VI (6:00~pm-7:30~pm) and the VII period (7:40~pm-9:10~pm) on weekdays.

It also shall be conducted on Saturday, Sunday or as intensive classes.
